PLEASE FILL OUT A PERMIT FORM EACH YEAR TO KEEP ON FILE IN THE OFFICE.

YOU MUST HAVE A VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE. IF YOU ONLY HAVE YOUR TEMPORARY LEARNER'S PERMIT, YOU NEED TO COME BACK WHEN YOU HAVE OBTAINED YOUR DRIVER'S LICENSE AND ARE INSURED.

I UNDERSTAND that I am responsible for my automobile and any accident it may be involved in, and that my parking privilege may be revoked for the violation of any traffic laws on the school grounds or using the auto for any reason during school hours other than arriving or leaving school at the end of the day.

I WILL drive with caution and use good sense at all times, maintain a minimum speed while driving on school property, obey all motor vehicle rules and regulations, report any accident immediately to the office if it occurs on school grounds, and I understand any violation of these rules could result in forfeiture of driving privileges for the remainder of the school year.

I WILL inform the office on the occasion that I should get a new car. The office will need to know the year, make and model of car, license number, model and color of new car in order to update Student Parking Form.

I WILL NOT go to my automobile during school hours or during any period without permission from the office, park in visitor spaces, staff spaces, fire lanes, handicapped spaces, painted Senior parking spaces, on the grass, write anything offensive on my car, race my engine or squeal my tires, and I understand any violation of these rules could result in forfeiture of driving privileges for the remainder of the school year.

I UNDERSTAND that Harrison High School does NOT have an open campus lunch time program. I am not permitted to leave school property without administrative approval.

I AGREE to abide by the rules and regulations. Violation will bring action by the administration, which could mean suspension of driving privileges, either temporarily or permanently.

***** ATTENTION *****

There are many pedestrians in the school parking lot and near the roads adjacent to the school. Drivers must use extreme caution. Unsafe driving will certainly bring temporary or permanent suspension of school driving privileges. Repeated unsafe driving on or near school grounds could bring action by the Harrison Police Department. Such action with the Police Department could result in the suspension of the student's driver's license.
